WHY THIS MATTERS FOR PROJECTS

- The EPD assesses impacts from raw-material extraction through recovery of demolition waste.
- EMAS requires an environmental statement validated by an accredited independent verifier.
- HPD and FDES documentation can support material-health and project-assessment requirements.

PROJECT EVIDENCE AND QUALIFICATION

- ISO 14001 environmental-management system.
- Select the declaration that covers the correct Imola product and manufacturing route.
- Confirm document validity and scheme requirements for each project.

Important: Environmental performance, recycled content and certification coverage can vary by collection, format, finish, production site and declaration period. Obtain the current manufacturer documentation for the exact product before relying on a claim.
